OUR PURPOSE

is to provide affordable room and board for 80 deserving UF students along with experience in self-governance and social cooperation.

WE ARE AFFORDABLE

because we work as a team, sharing responsibilities such as cleaning the bathrooms, the kitchen, and other common areas while attending to minor house maintenance efforts.

We manage the organization ourselves via an elected Board of Directors, elected officers, and monthly house meetings attended by all members.

We own our property free and clear via a trust deed. Dr. Joseph Fulk, a UF professor gave CLO the land in 1947 as a memorial to his wife Nellie Swanson Fulk.

New concrete buildings were built in the early 1970's with the help of a government loan that has since been paid off. An active CLO Alumni Foundation provides additional help if needed.

WHAT IS CLO?

We are a student-run cooperative housed in two Residential Buildings and one Commons Building located one block from UF's main campus.

The commons building includes a kitchen, a dining room, CLO offices, and a recreation room.

We have a computer lab with high-speed Internet connections to every member's room.

Each room is designed for two people that share a bathroom with eight other people. The rooms are furnished with two beds, desks, dressers, and closet spaces.

We have a parking lot for cars but many residents live at CLO without a car. We have bike racks and our own laundry facilities.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- Submit the CLO application form.
- Be interviewed & accepted by CLO.
- Pell eligible, full-time undergraduate students are given priority.
- Graduate, foreign and Non-Pell Grant eligible students should also provide a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), see:
